Job Purpose:

We are seeking a highly motivated individual to be responsible for enabling the delivery of County Development Activities. Working closely with Ulster Camogie Growth and Participation Officers, the successful candidate will engage with County Boards in the process of developing tailored Development Plans.

Main Areas of Responsibility:

- 1. Working with Development Team to deliver on the following programmes
- Club Development and Planning programmes/workshops
- Club and County Officer Volunteer Training
- Volunteer Recruitment Support
- Development and review of Funding Model to assist County Boards affiliated to Ulster Camogie
- 2. Collaborate with Camogie Association and Ulster GAA to deliver an appropriate Volunteer Development Pathway to members.
- 3. Promote and deliver the Club Compas programme. Use Club Compas as a resource to keep clubs and Counties up to date with and focused on Policy and Best Practice in the Community and Voluntary Sector. Maintain an up-to-date record of clubs engaging in the programme.
- 4. Signpost all Units to any potential funding opportunities and provide support and guidance to any club development queries.
- 5. Provide clubs and Counties with ongoing support with their tailored Development Plans.
- 6. Participate in Organisational training, staff reviews and appraisals.
- 7. Knowledge of the Camogie Association and its structures.
